The Promo Revisited and I Give Up!



Promo in the Spotlight!

For those of you who are new to our monthly newsletter - welcome! We're blessed to have you join us. In this month's edition, I will try and give a bit more clarity to our promo video, as well as introduce three additional members of our team. There will be more to come next month . . . all so you know who's behind the scenes of this mammoth project.



The silly season is upon us! Some are experiencing the dry hot conditions the southern hemisphere has to offer whilst others are experiencing the cold white fluffy stuff that's starting to fall. Wherever you are in this vast beautiful world that God has blessed us with we pray that Jesus our crucified and risen Saviour is the absolute centre of your world!

Let's jump into a closer look at the promo video. Just to film this was a miracle in so many ways. God sent a precious soul to fund the entire video clip and scouting trip. As our journey progressed, the Holy Spirit sent words of encouragement through our sponsor that cheered us forward on a sometimes very difficult road (near death for Craig). We are eternally grateful for the one who financed and supported this effort.

First, I want to give a little more insight into how the script came to be.

After years of prayer and a gradual understanding of what God was calling us to to do came the unenviable task of condensing all the detail into a short video that tried to paint the picture of this entire project. A seemingly impossible feat! But there is One who could - so I prayed and asked the Lord to write the script. The promo was the result.

Set back in the late 1800's, the first few scenes reveal a little girl, a mature aged gentleman, and a well to do businessman. The poor little girl discovers a piece of silver. She cannot believe her eyes - it's a days wage! She knows exactly what she will do with it - her family will be able to eat. The mature gentleman steps off the train - his journey has been tough. He's been a hard worker and his reward has been fair. He too finds silver. He wants to put it to good use but he's not quite sure where. Finally the well to do businessman is running late. The day is drawing to a close as he stops to wipe the sweat from his brow. In so doing he drops a few pieces of silver. It's a few days hard earned wages for others, but for him it's almost worthless. There's no time to pick them up - he must keep going. After all he has enough anyway.

We all fit somewhere in amongst these three people . . .

Thirty pieces of silver was considered a lot of money in Jesus' day. Some say it was only a weeks wage while others contend it was about 4 months earnings. In any case it was what our Saviour was sold for. Heartbreaking, as we know God gave us everything when He gave His Son. He was worth an infinite amount. In fact, inspiration tells us He was worth all of heaven! When Jesus was sold for just thirty pieces, the enemy thought he could end the hope of salvation for all. Not a chance . . . God used that opportunity to turn the terrible cross into something beautiful - salvation for all who believe! Hallelujah! The beautiful terrible cross!



So, 'What is He worth to you?' is the question posed at the end of the promo. It's simple in its meaning. Christ surrendered everything. What are you willing to surrender . . . your time, skills, talent's, positions, money - to help spread this end time message? And if so, here's an opportunity for you to join us on this huge evangelistic campaign and contribute where you can.

How much is a soul worth? It's not a trick question. Jesus Christ died for each one of us which means we are each worth all of heaven. It's an infinite amount that's completely incalculable. But since we live in a world that seems to respond to everything in economic and monetary terms, lets consider some statistics that show how the cost of this project actually relates to souls for the Kingdom.

According to Sandy Padula, an independent consultant hired by the producers of The Chosen, over 108 million people globally have watched at least part of one episode (as of November 2022). If we were to reach just half that number with the Steps to Christ project (being very conservative in our numbers), investing ten million US dollars makes each soul reached with the truth worth less than 20 cents! Incredible! When we consider the platform of multiple languages that Steps to Christ will present, I believe we can easily reach more than The Chosen, which would make each soul worth close to nothing in monetary terms. What's presented will be The Truth as it is in Jesus - a real and saving relationship instead of Bible error and false revival. Remember, our Christ given task is to reach not convert. Christ gave everything on the hope of a soul, not the promise.

If that's not compelling enough, consider this. If one was to invest the capital in this project and then seek to recover the investment by crowdfunding or the like, the statistics from The Chosen tell us that, "As of 2021, viewers (of The Chosen) had contributed \$40 million towards its production". Unbelievable amounts of financial support from those who really desire to know Jesus! Imagine how much support they would give to know The Truth as it is in Jesus. Isn't that an investment worth making?

We need to rethink our media productions. Generally speaking the Seventh-day Adventist organisation has experienced success, but of late it appears the numbers are shrinking - we are struggling. Unfortunately the methods that worked in times past are no longer cutting through. We should not be discouraged. In fact we should be encouraged to seek out new ways to reach our dying world. The end is near - more than ever we must be more persistent, bold, and explore new opportunities.



With the Lord at the helm this project is to meet The Chosen head on in a number ways. Not the least of them is viewership and truth. There are hungering souls the world over seeking for truth like never before. We have an opportunity to put an incredibly powerful book before them in a way that has never been done before.

We are HIS masterpiece - each one of us! Now He's placing the finishing touches on all of us. Like never before, we must give everyone the opportunity to experience the blessing of Steps to Christ. Now it's time to give a fallen world the last day message of how to know Him - The Way, The Truth, and The Life! This power packed, inspired little book holds a revelation every soul needs. A message of love and surrender. A message from the giver of life!

The purpose behind the promo's old world theme is that Steps to Christ will be set in that era and location. Whilst the actors used in the promo are not the actors to be used in the main production, you still get a sense of what the film will look like.
