On the day the world defines as Easter Sunday I had an unforgettable experience. Amongst a crowd of people our youngest daughter had a near fainting episode. She went white, her lips blue, her blood pressure dived and her pulse was barely readable. The paramedics were called, and a passerby who was Doctor rendered assistance. After what seemed like forever she came around - not completely but enough for us to continue on. As a parent, there is little worse than looking on helplessly at your suffering child. If only I could take her place. As is so often the case, it's in times of despair that we listen carefully to hear the voice of the Lord. He reminded me whose daughter she really was. She is not mine, she is His. All I could do at that point was to say, "She's Yours Father - I trust that whatever happens is in Your hands and You will do whatever is best for her. Her life is Yours because You are the One who gave her life". I felt a peace that He was very near.

Two days later anxiety grips again. This same daughter was now at home when we received a phone call from our eldest son Jack. "Mum, Montana is having some form of seizure". After a rushed drive to the emergency department, blood tests, and hours waiting for the results, we had the diagnosis . . . low iron!

How can such a seemingly insignificant mineral have such a significant impact? Quite simply, if you don't have all the components right the body doesn't function correctly. Such an easy fix to what seemed at the



time a possible life threatening event.

This got me thinking about the spiritual lesson that God may have had for us. If you or I are not doing our part in the body of Christ, we may think that nobody will notice. We may even consider we're not that significant in the bigger picture and any effort withheld will easily go unnoticed. Such a perspective is false. Irrespective of how little we think of our best contribution, it is still critical in the body of Christ. Whether it be financial, service, or even prayer, any contribution, seen or unseen and however small is vital in the well organised function of God's church. Everyone of us forms part of the lifeblood that energises this last day movement. God longs for everyone of us to fulfil the responsibility He has placed before us. He desires to bless us through an intimate relationship with Jesus that is witness to His calling on our lives. We must be a hearer AND a doer of His word.

Beloved, the body of Christ appears to be failing. But we need not despair. It may appear that it's a hopeless situation and that some parts of the body are too far gone . . . Look up! Your redemption draws nigh! The King is still on His throne. He has given each one of us just the right amount of faith to exercise - a mustard seed worth - an amount so small that can still move a mountain.

I choose to watch this seed grow into a tree that will feed, shade and house God's beloved people. If just one of His precious children takes courage and looks to Him through this message and the messages He has given us to share, then it has all been worth it.

To help bring the lost sheep home is what we as a ministry have been called to do. And whilst ever God grants us the strength and time to do His will, we pray we will stay faithful to His calling. All will be accomplished in His perfect timing. Steps to Christ the film WILL happen . . . in His way, in His time and by His provision.
